GLOBALIZATION

- **United Nations reaction – March-April**
(to develop COVID19 vaccine, to stop all wars; to abolish all sanctions)
- **G20 online summit on COVID-19 – March**
(safeguard people's jobs and incomes, revive growth, minimize disruptions to trade and global supply chains, provide help to all countries in need of assistance)
- **Global online-summit on COVID-19 – June**
(raised US\$8.8 billion in pledges to help Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance)
- **Other actors strengthening – March-June**

- **Closed borders**
(EU measures, tourism downturn, labour migration)
- **Protectionism measures**
(FDI Act, sanctions against Huawei, Defense Production Act)
- **Isolationism policy**
(US concentration on domestic issues)
- **Charges against WHO**
(cutoff allocations, US and Brazil position)
